

How to print team medical releases

Go to www.gotsoccer.com and click on "User Login"

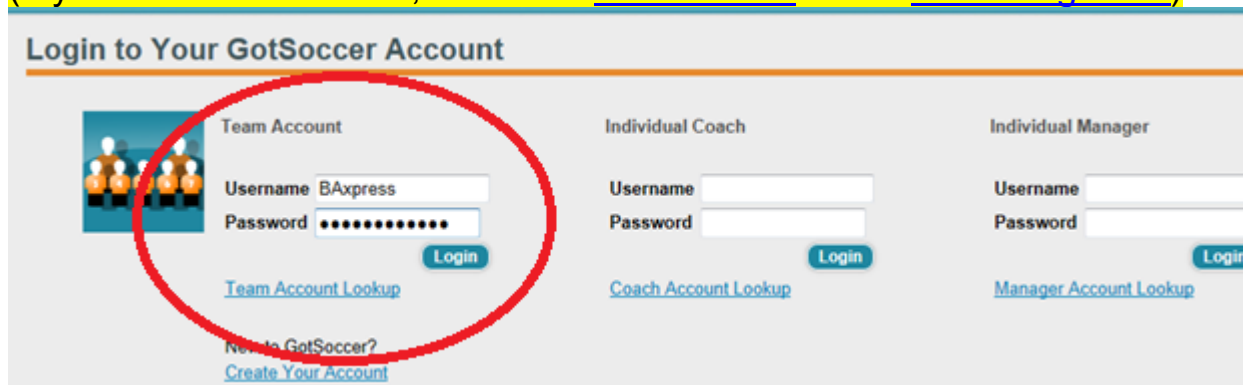


Now scroll down to "Teams & Team Officials" and click Login:



Log into your "TEAM account" with your username & password.
